AN IDEA IS BORN, PLAYERS TAKE UP THE CHALLENGE

European football and rugby cups, as well as other sports, have accomplished much more than treaties in instilling the feeling of belonging to « the European continent » in the hearts and minds of European citizens.

This therefore led to the idea of organising amateur sporting fixtures where, promoted by a team wearing its colours, Europe would reinforce its vitality and identity.



One shirt, one mentalityt

Europe in Sport is first and foremost a mentality. The main aim is to promote a feeling of belonging to a united and diverse team in order to represent and promote the European colours within the context of fair play and team spirit.

AN EUROPEAN FEDERATION

The European Federation Europe in Sport settled for mission to promote the emergence of the European shirt, whatever the played sports discipline is.

As part of this mission, the Federation favors the presence of associations Europe in the countries part of the European Union and research the support of national sports federations to promote the emergence of the European shirt.

EUROPE IN SPORT has in particular vocation in every country, in:

- Strengthen by the sport the notion of membership and European identity with the citizens, by inviting the sports organizations to integrate in their demonstrations a «Team of Europe» which carry and defends the European shirt;
- Organize sports events which give free rein to any idea the realization of which contributes to the implementation of a team of Europe;
- Contribute to the development of the sports practice and more generally the physical activity;
- Strengthen by the sport, the social link, the cohesion, the solidarity and the team spirit;
- Organize Trophies Europe in Sport to reward every year the sports organizations which support and\or lead for exemplary and dynamic actions to strengthen the notion of European membership by the sport.

- Young mascots wearing the European shirt accompany players onto the pitch,

International initiatives

Work together with sports federation candidates and members of the Europe in Sport support committee to organise intercontinental matches between the European Team and international teams.
